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1 Introduction

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Centra Gas Manitoba Inc. ("Centra") has a mandate is to acquire, manage and distribute
supplies of natural gas to meet Manitoba market requirements in a safe, cost-effective,
reliable and environmentally appropriate manner.
Centra holds contracts for gas transportation on the TransCanada Pipelines Mainline
system (TCPL) in Canada and the Great Lakes Gas Transmission (GLGT) system and
ANR Pipeline (ANR) gas transmission system in the United States. In addition, Centra

10 contracts for gas storage with ANR in Michigan. The GLGT and ANR transportation and 11 storage contracts expire on March 31, 2013 and Centra previously advised the PUB of 12 its plans to examine the design of its gas transportation and storage portfolio prior to the 13 expiry of the existing arrangements.

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15 There are three key questions to be addressed in the assessment of Centra's future16 supply, storage and transportation portfolio:

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Supply - Should the current supply configuration of natural gas shipped mainly
 from Alberta with seasonal injections and withdrawals from Michigan storage be
 maintained?

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2. Storage - Should Centra maintain, increase or decrease the amount of storage

currently contracted and if storage is still required, where should it be located?
 Transportation - Should Centra continue to rely solely on TCPL to deliver natural
 gas to the Centra service territory?

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5 Centra proposed a public consultation process to be employed in the course of 6 examining the future design of its gas transportation and storage portfolio, one which 7 would utilize the resources of an outside consultant to prepare a report that would 8 identify portfolio options for Centra to consider within the context of the North American 9 natural gas market. A technical conference would follow the distribution of the 10 consultant report.

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In Order 55/10, the PUB agreed with Centra's plan to develop a discussion paper that would be circulated to stakeholders. In addition, the PUB directed Centra to provide the PUB with a timeline of the process for replacing or renewing its gas transportation and storage assets. On October 28, 2010, Centra filed a Timeline of the Process for Replacing Transportation and Storage Arrangements.

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The PUB in Order 65/11 directed Centra to amend the process and timeline to include an information request process to occur after the technical conference. In addition, stakeholders would then be afforded the opportunity to provide feedback, comment and suggestions for Centra's consideration by way of a written submission to be prepared after the completion of the information request process. Furthermore, the PUB directed Centra to arrange for an oral public hearing before the PUB prior to the finalization of any new contracting arrangements.

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1 In response to this direction, Centra amended the process and filed a draft timetable with 2 the PUB on May 19, 2011. The amended process includes the provision of a discussion 3 paper, followed by a technical conference on July 8, 2011. Centra has scheduled a 4 round of information requests to address the gas supply, storage and transportation 5 matters and the information contained in the discussion paper. Stakeholders are to 6 provide information requests to Centra by July 21, 2011 and Centra is scheduled to 7 provide responses on August 12, 2011. After the submission of the responses, 8 intervenors would be expected to provide written submissions to clearly identify any 9 concerns or other alternatives that Centra should consider in its evaluation of 10 alternatives. Parties would also be entitled to provide other comments pertinent to the 11 replacement of the expiring arrangements. Stakeholders would be expected to provide 12 their written submissions to Centra and the PUB by August 25, 2011.

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14 The PUB responded to Centra's letter on May 26, 2011 and found the proposed 15 schedule and timetable to be acceptable. The PUB circulated the letter to all Registered 16 Intervenors and to date no comments were forthcoming.

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18 **Consultant Report**

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Attachment 1 to this submission is a report prepared by ICF International titled "Review of Natural Gas Supply Portfolio Options for Centra Gas". The purpose of this report is to provide Centra and interested stakeholders with an overview of the concepts and issues associated with a wide array of gas supply portfolio options in the context of the North American natural gas market. The consultant report provides an overview of such matters as:

1 • the North American natural gas market and the significant changes that have 2 occurred in recent years; 3 the load characteristics of the Manitoba market and the current gas supply 4 portfolio that Centra employs in serving that market; 5 • the nature of the uncertainty facing Centra regarding the TCPL Mainline; and 6 the gas supply portfolio options that Centra may consider. 7 8 **Technical Conference** 9 10 A technical conference is proposed to be held on Friday, July 8, 2011 at Manitoba 11 Hydro's head office at 360 Portage Avenue in Winnipeg. The purpose of the technical 12 conference is to allow a comprehensive discussion and exploration of the issues, 13 matters and terminology applicable in the examination of the various gas supply, storage 14 and transportation alternatives. 15 16 This technical conference is to be conducted "without prejudice", to better facilitate and 17 achieve a more open and complete dialogue in an informal setting. Centra is not yet in a 18 position to make an Application to the PUB on these matters, but views the technical 19 conference as an important way to allow stakeholders to freely ask questions or seek 20 clarification from Centra, encourage meaningful dialogue, and for stakeholders to 21 provide input and feedback to Centra for consideration of potential alternatives to be 22 pursued. 23

The agenda for the Technical Conference is found in Attachment 2 to this submission, and is being distributed to registered intervenors of past record, registered gas

1 marketers, large volume customers and the PUB. Centra requests that interested parties 2 confirm their intention to attend, either in person or by way of teleconference, by July 5, 3 2011. 4 5 Information Request Process 6 7 As noted above Centra views the discussions that take place at the technical conference 8 to be without prejudice and not formally part of the record for any subsequent Application 9 in regard to these matters. Centra views the information request process as the 10 originating point for the evidentiary portion of the regulatory Application process. 11 12 Stakeholders will have the opportunity to submit information requests to Centra on the 13 matters associated with the gas supply, storage and transportation portfolio and the 14 content of the consultant report. These information requests are to be received by 15 Centra by July 21, 2011 and Centra will provide responses to the stakeholders by 16 August 12, 2011. 17 18 Stakeholder Submissions 19 20 With the consultant report and ensuing technical conference, stakeholders will have 21 been provided the opportunity to gain a common understanding of the North American

natural gas market, the various gas supply, storage and transportation options and the issues facing Centra in its examination of those options. Stakeholders will have the opportunity to ask questions on the written record on these matters through the information request process. After those steps have been completed, Centra will

request that stakeholders provide their feedback and input by way of written submissions
 by August 25, 2011.

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It is important to note that at this stage, Centra has not drawn any conclusions regarding its preferred gas supply, storage and transportation arrangements post March, 2013. Centra has engaged in discussions with many parties that provide transportation and storage services, and continues to hold discussions with a number of parties and to evaluate portfolio options. However, no conclusions will be reached on these matters until later in 2011.

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11 Stakeholders therefore have the opportunity to provide their perspectives on Centra's 12 gas supply, storage and transportation portfolio by way of written submission to be 13 provided as per the above noted schedule. It is proposed that stakeholder submissions 14 would constitute part of the formal regulatory record for the subsequent public review 15 process for Centra's Application.

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17 Regulatory Application Process

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19 Centra will continue its discussions with storage and transportation providers regarding 20 its portfolio options. Centra's economic and operational analysis of its portfolio options 21 will be based on its ongoing discussions and will also consider stakeholder input. Upon 22 completing its analysis, Centra will make Application to the PUB for approval of its 23 preferred portfolio design, complete with the justification to support the preferred 24 portfolio.

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- 1 The date and procedural steps for the review of Centra's forthcoming Application have
- 2 not been determined at this time. It is expected that Centra will be in a position to
- 3 propose an appropriate regulatory review process, including an oral public hearing, in
- 4 due course.
