<p>1. The City is the single largest consumer of hydro-electric power in the Province of Manitoba in the Area and Roadway Lighting class, expending over \$11,000,000 per year. A rate increase would have a significant impact on the budget of the Public Works Department of the City, which would be carried forward into the budget of the City and ultimately, imposed on its taxpayers.</p> <p>2. With the introduction of LED luminaires, the City proposes to review the interim rates charged by Manitoba Hydro in the Area and Roadway Lighting as a result of PUB Order 79/14 and the rates proposed by Manitoba Hydro in this General Rate Application for all technologies and wattages within the Area and Roadway Lighting class.</p> <p>3. The City proposes to review the quantity of luminaires identified in the Manitoba Hydro invoices paid for by the City in the Area and Roadway Lighting class.</p> <p>4. Given that the City owns properties that fall within the 30kv – 100kv and >100kv categories of the General Service Large class, the City proposes to review the application and impact of Time-of-Use rates on these properties.</p> <p>5. Given the City's experience in utilizing a range of options that mitigate the cost and risk associated with the financing of major capital projects exclusively with debt, the City proposes to examine options that could be utilized by Manitoba Hydro to mitigate the upward pressure on rates due to the anticipated impact of Manitoba Hydro's anticipated capital expenditures on its future capital structure.</p>
