MPI to provide the split of who has vehicles and who doesn't out of the roughly 47 million in driver premium.

RESPONSE:

There were 834,670 active drivers as of October 1, 2014 of which 281,293 (33.7%) did not have a Major Class 1, 2, 3, or 4 vehicle registered in their name. Approximately \$16 million of the \$47 million in driver premium is from drivers without a vehicle registered. The amount may be slightly higher or lower depending on the distribution of drivers by DSR level.
