<u>Undertaking #119:</u> CAC panel to return to the survey of household spending and clarify whether the shelter definition would capture some homes heated by electricity.

Response:

For slides 4, 6, and 7, the shelter costs for the principal residence excludes any expenditures for electricity whether for electric heating or not. Thus the shelter costs include the cost of heating only if it is with gas or some other form of non-electric heat.
