Economic Impact Analysis

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 The purpose of this presentation is to present the economic impacts of the Preferred Development Plan (PDP) on Manitoba in terms of:

- Employment (Direct, Indirect and Induced)
- Labour Income
- Tax Revenue
- Domestic Product



Economic Impact Analysis Methodology

- The methodology used in estimating impacts is:
 - The Manitoba Bureau of Statistics Input-Output (I-O) Model
 - Break down overall expenditures per project by appropriate goods and services and by jurisdiction in which expenditures will take place i.e. Manitoba, Rest of Canada and Foreign.
 - The Non- Manitoba sourced expenditures represent leakage or loss to local economy.
 - The model provides estimates of Direct, Indirect and Induced impacts of the Project on Manitoba and Canada.

Manitoba Benefits of the PDP
