2. The water rates set forth in Schedule "A" hereto shall apply to all customers of the utility effective on the next billing in the normal course after the date of this Order.

## SCHEDULE OF QUARTERLY RATES:

1. Commodity rates per M.G.

All water consumption - Water $\$ 2.35$
2. Minimum Charges, Quarterly

Notwithstanding the Commodity rates set forth in paragraph 1 hereof, all customers will pay the applicable minimum charges set out below, which will include water allowances indicated:
(a) Water Customers

Minimum charge will be the same for each meter size as shown above.
3. Billings and Penalties

Accounts shall be billed quarterly, and shall be due and payable 30 days after the date of billing. A penalty of $10 \%$ of the amount of the bill shall be added if not paid by the due date. (Note: due date may be set as Council sees fit to do.)
4. Disconnection

Service may be disconnected and discontinued immediately and without further notice in the event of non-payment of the
account within 30 days after due date.

6. Outstanding Bills

Pursuant to Section $236(1)(\mathrm{b})$ of The Municipal Act, the amount of all outstanding charges for water service are a lien and charge upon the land serviced, and shall be collected in the same manner in which ordinary taxes upon the land are collectible, and with like remedies.
7. Water Allowance Due to Line Freezing

That in any case where, at the request of the Council, a customer allows water to run continuously for any period of time to prevent the water lines in the water system from freezing, the charge to that customer for the current quarter shall be the average of the billings for the last two previous quarters to the same customer, or to the same premises if the occupant has changed.
