**WHEREAS** the Rural Municipality of Ochre River serving Local Improvement District No. 1 (Ochre River) has applied to The Public Utilities Board for approval of By-law No. 11/01 to revise the schedule of sewer rates of the said Municipality, and after public notice of the application - no persons signifying their desire to make representation in the matter;

**AND WHEREAS** the Board deems it expedient to do so;

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. By-law No. 11/01 of the Rural Municipality of Ochre River serving Local Improvement District No. 1 (Ochre River) BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY APPROVED;
2. The sewer rates set forth in Schedule "A" hereto shall apply to all customers of the utility effective on the next billing in the normal course after the date of this Order.

SEWER RATES

BY-LAW NO. 11/01

SCHEDULE OF QUARTERLY RATES:

1. Quarterly Charges

All customers will pay the applicable charges set out below:

2. Billings and Penalties

Accounts shall be billed quarterly, and shall be due and payable 30 days after date of billing. A penalty of 10% of the amount of the bill shall be added if not paid by the due date.

3. Outstanding Bills

Pursuant to Section 236(1) of The Municipal Act, the amount of all outstanding charges for sewer service are a lien and charge upon the land serviced, and shall be collected in the same manner in which ordinary taxes upon the land are collectable, and with like remedies.

4. The rates and service charges set forth in the said schedule shall be levied from the date on which any building is connected to a sewer line.

5. In the event that more than one business or commercial undertaking of any kind is carried on in any building, a separate charge shall be levied against the owner or proprietor of each business or commercial undertaking whose premises are connected to the sewerage system.
