(b) Water Only Customers

Minimum charge will be the same for each meter size as shown above, but the Sewer Commodity charge will be excluded.

(c) Sewer Only for Residential Customers

The Town of Morris do charge the owners or occupants of land serviced with sewer but no water the sum of \$11.30 per quarter.

3. Bulk Sales Rate

All water sold in bulk by the Town of Morris shall be charged for at the rate of \$9.30 per 1,000 gallons on a pro-rated basis for all quantities greater than 500 gallons.

4. Service to Customers outside Municipality, Town or LUD limits

The Council of the Town of Morris may sign agreements with customers for the provision of water and sewer services to properties located outside the legal boundaries of the Town. Such agreements shall provide for payment of the appropriate rates set out in the schedule, as well as a surcharge, set by resolution of Council which shall be equivalent to the frontage levy, general taxes and special taxes for utility purposes in effect at the time, or may be in effect from time to time, and which would be levied on the property concerned if it were within these boundaries. In addition, all costs of connection to the utility's mains and installing and maintaining service connections will be paid by the customer.

5. Billings and Penalties

Accounts shall be billed quarterly, and shall be due and payable 30 days after date of billing. A penalty of 10% of the amount of the bill shall be added if not paid by the due date.
