## RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MINIOTA LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 (MINIOTA) SEWER UTILITY ANTICIPATED DEFICIT 2009

WHEREAS Section 165(2) of *The Municipal Act*, SM 1996, c. 58, as amended, provides:

"165(2) When a council determines during a fiscal year that expenditures of a utility are likely to exceed the revenue and transfers provided for in the utility budget, the council must immediately advise The Public Utilities Board in writing and may incur a deficiency with the Board's written approval, which may include any condition the Board considers necessary or advisable."

**AND WHEREAS** the Rural Municipality of Miniota serving Local Improvement District No. 1 (Miniota) anticipates incurring a deficit during the 2009 year in the sewer utility in an amount estimated at \$2,971.41;

**AND WHEREAS** the said cause of the anticipated deficit is a result of the amortization expense of utility assets and the interest portion of the debenture debt payment;

**AND WHEREAS** it is proposed that the said deficit be recovered from the utility's accumulated surplus;

AND WHEREAS rates were last reviewed in 2008.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- The 2009 anticipated deficit of the sewer utility of the Rural Municipality of Miniota serving Local Improvement District No. 1 (Miniota) estimated at \$2,971.41, for the purposes set out herein, BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY APPROVED to be recovered from accumulated surplus, as requested.
- The Rural Municipality of Miniota file with the Public 2. Utilities Board a copy of a resolution of council, the final amount of the deficit incurred in 2009, no later than April 1, 2010.
- If, at the end of the year, the actual amount of the deficit 3. exceeds \$10,000 or 5% of the utilities operating budget, or if the cause of the deficit differs from that approved herein, the Rural Municipality of Miniota serving Local Improvement District No. 1 (Miniota) shall advise the Board by no later than April 1, 2010 and seek the Board's approval for recovery thereof.
- The Rural Municipality of Miniota review the rates of the 4. sewer utility for adequacy and provide a report to the Public Utilities Board, no later than September 30, 2010.
