## RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BROKENHEAD WATER AND SEWER UTILITY ACTUAL DEFICIT 2009

WHEREAS the Public Utilities Board issued Order No. 151/08 on November 7, 2008 requiring all water and/or sewer utilities to report an actual year-end deficit to the Board if the utility:

- 1. had not received prior approval for the deficit from the Board and such deficit either exceeds \$10,000 or represents 5% of the utility's operating budget; or
- 2. had received prior approval for the deficit from the Board and the actual deficit:
  - a. exceeds the previously approved amount by either \$10,000 or 5% of the utility's operating budget; or
  - b. is caused as a result that differs from that upon which said approval was granted;

**AND WHEREAS** the Rural Municipality of Brokenhead incurred a net deficit at the end of the 2009 operating year in the water and sewer utility of \$67,208;

**AND WHEREAS** the said cause of the deficit is a result of amortization expense;

AND WHEREAS it is proposed that the said deficit be recovered by drawing down on the utility's fund surplus, which as at December 31, 2009 held a working capital surplus of \$88,003 (\$193,726 with the lagoon reserve);

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The actual net deficit of the water and sewer utility of the Rural Municipality of Brokenhead incurred in 2009 in the amount of \$67,208, for the purposes set out herein, BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY APPROVED to be recovered through the utility's accumulated surplus.
- 2. The Rural Municipality of Brokenhead review its rates for adequacy and file a report with the Public Utilities Board, as well as an application for revised rates if required, by October 31, 2011.
