**TOWN OF MINITONAS
WATER AND SEWER UTILITY
ACTUAL DEFICIT 2011**

WHEREAS the Public Utilities Board issued Order No. 151/08 on November 7, 2008 requiring all water and/or sewer utilities to report an actual year-end deficit to the Board if the utility:

1. had not received prior approval for the deficit from the Board and such deficit either exceeds \$10,000 or represents 5% of the utility's operating budget; or
2. had received prior approval for the deficit from the Board and the actual deficit:
 - a. exceeds the previously approved amount by either \$10,000 or 5% of the utility's operating budget; or
 - b. is caused as a result that differs from that upon which said approval was granted;

AND WHEREAS the **Town of Minitonas** Water and Sewer Utility (Utility) incurred an operating deficit at the end of the 2011 operating year of \$1,440.00, when calculated for regulatory purposes;

AND WHEREAS the said cause of the deficit are fees for the certification of the Assistant Foreman;

AND WHEREAS it is proposed that said deficit be recovered from the utility nominal surplus account;

Board decisions may be appealed in accordance with the provisions of Section 58 of *The Public Utilities Board Act*, or reviewed in accordance with Section 36 of the Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules). The Board's Rules may be viewed on the Board's website at www.pub.gov.mb.ca.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The actual 2011 operating deficit, when calculated for regulatory purposes, of \$1,440.00 incurred by the **Town of Minitonas** Sewer Utility Operations, for the purposes set out herein, is HEREBY APPROVED to be recovered from the utility nominal surplus account.
