WATER UTILITY  
ACTUAL DEFICIT 2010**

**WHEREAS** the Public Utilities Board issued Order No. 151/08 on November 7, 2008 requiring all water and/or sewer utilities to report an actual year-end deficit to the Board if the utility:

1. had not received prior approval for the deficit from the Board and such deficit either exceeds \$10,000 or represents 5% of the utility's operating budget; or
2. had received prior approval for the deficit from the Board and the actual deficit:
  - a. exceeds the previously approved amount by either \$10,000 or 5% of the utility's operating budget; or
  - b. is caused as a result that differs from that upon which said approval was granted;

**AND WHEREAS** the Rural Municipality of South Norfolk - LUD of Rathwell Water Utility (Utility) incurred an operating deficit at the end of the 2010 operating year of \$14,245, when calculated for regulatory purposes;

**AND WHEREAS** it is proposed that the reason for said deficit is a result of conversion to Public Sector Accounting Board Standards;

**AND WHEREAS** it is proposed that the 2010 deficit of \$14,245 be recovered from the Utility Surplus Fund;

**AND WHEREAS** it is proposed that a pending rate study be submitted as soon as possible or by September 30, 2013.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. The actual 2010 operating deficit, when calculated for regulatory purposes, of \$14,245 incurred in the **Rural Municipality of South Norfolk - LUD of Rathwell** Water Utility (Utility) Operations, for the purposes set out herein, is HEREBY APPROVED to be recovered from the Utility Surplus;
