NOTICE OF DECISION

The Public Utilities Board (Board) approved an increase in Stittco Utilities Man Ltd.'s (Stittco) propane commodity rate from \$0.4219/m³ to \$0.4646/m³ for propane consumed on or after November 1, 2015. Propane is sold with no mark-up by Stittco. The Board also approved a 4.4% increase in non-commodity rates effective November 1, 2015. The combined impact of these decisions is an expected increase of the average residential bill by approximately 5.7% depending on propane consumption.

Commodity rates are reviewed quarterly in accordance with a Board-approved methodology. Noncommodity rates are reviewed annually and reflect operating costs, income taxes, depreciation and a provision for a rate of return on Stittco's investment.
