### NOTICE OF DECISION

April 27, 2016

By Board Order 57/16, the Public Utilities Board (Board) approved Centra Gas Manitoba Inc.'s (Centra) application to decrease the current Primary Gas rate from \$0.0942/m<sup>3</sup> to \$0.0819/m<sup>3</sup> effective May 1, 2016. Primary Gas is sold at cost by Centra to Manitoba customers.

The projected annual bill impact for a typical residential customer as a result of the Primary Gas rate decrease is a decrease of approximately 3.3% or \$25/year. Primary Gas rates will be reviewed again August 1, 2016.

Primary Gas rates for customers that have signed fixed-term fixed-price contracts, with either Centra or a private broker, are not affected.
