PERPETUAL CARE FUNDS OF CHAPEL CEMETERY
PASSING OF ACCOUNTS 2010-2012

1.0 Application

Wiebe Funeral Homes Ltd. (Wiebe) made application to the Public Utilities Board (Board) for the Passing of Accounts for the perpetual care fund of Chapel Cemetery (Cemetery), in accordance with *The Cemeteries Act C.C.M.C.C.30* (Act) for the three-year period from January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2012.

In support of this application, Wiebe filed the following information:

- Chapel Cemetery Financial Transactions for 2010, 2011 and 2012;
- Continuity Schedule of Perpetual Care Trust Fund;
- Schedule of Allotments to Perpetual Care Trust Fund;
- Continuity schedule of plot sales;
- TD Canada Trust Statements for 2010 to 2012;
- Allocation of expenses between Perpetual Care Trust Fund and other;
- Budget Forecast for 2013, 2014 and 2015; and
- Actual vs. Budget 2010 to 2012.
- Affidavit-Signed and Dated

2.0 Board Finding

Having reviewed the application and supporting information for the period 2010 to 2012 inclusive, the Board is satisfied that Wiebe's perpetual care funds have been dealt with in accordance with the Act. The Board will therefore pass the accounts.

The Board is of the view that the time interval between the passing of accounts should not exceed three years, and will therefore direct that Wiebe file an application with the Board for passing accounts for the period January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2015 by no later than May 31, 2016.

3.0 It Is Therefore Ordered That:

1. An account of Wiebe Funeral Homes Ltd.'s dealings with the perpetual care funds of Chapel Cemetery for the three year period of 2010, 2011 and 2012, are pursuant to Section 31(2) of *The Cemeteries Act*, BE AND IS HEREBY PASSED.
2. Wiebe Funeral Homes Ltd. file an application with the Public Utilities Board for the passing of accounts for the perpetual care fund of Chapel Cemetery for the three-year period for 2013 to 2015 inclusive, no later than May 31, 2016.
