RE: MANITOBA HYDRO'S 2015 COST OF SERVICE METHODOLOGY REVIEW – WORKSHOP UNDERTAKINGS

On May 11th, May 12th and May 13th, 2016, Manitoba Hydro held Workshops with respect to the 2015 Cost of Service Methodology Review. In accordance with the timelines established for this Review, please find enclosed Manitoba Hydro's responses to the majority of Undertakings requested by the PUB and Interveners during the Workshops. Manitoba Hydro anticipates filing a response to Undertaking 19 this week.

Manitoba Hydro has also included responses to five requests for information that were made during the Workshops at Transcript pages 254, 255, 602, 603, and 791, but were not recorded as Undertakings.

Two Undertakings, 18 and 20, were taken under advisement by Manitoba Hydro. Manitoba Hydro has reviewed these requests and has concluded that these are beyond the scope of this Review as the requested information does not address the allocation of costs related to load expansions. At Transcript pages 819-820, Mr. Bill Grant, PUB-Appointed Facilitator for the Workshops, stated as follows:

The Board jurisdiction issue we want to stay away from completely. And so that to my mind would include any discussion of the merits of the existing extension policy would therefore be out, but -- but the components of what the cost is under the existing extension policy is fair ball.

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Manitoba Hydro further notes that the treatment of costs arising from service extension policy was discussed at Transcripts pages 822-828 and 831-836.
