OIL BUOYS MARKETS

RONTO • The Toronto stock exchange ersed course from the previous day's loss to post a triple-digit gain Tuesday rig-zagging oil prices rose sharply.

Flie S&P/TSX composite index closed 188.16 points at 12,331.32, following a point decline on Monday.

The heavily weighted energy subtor rose by more than four per cent as March contract for North American felimark crude oil rose \$1.11 to settle at \$31.45 a barrel.

The commodity-sensitive loonie was o a big beneficiary of the jump in oil ses, rising 0.97 of a cent to end trading JS71.05 cents.

The last time the loonie closed above US71 cents was on Jan. 6 and the currency fell as low as US68.21 cents last week, according to Bank of Canada data.

In other commodities the March contract for natural gas added 0.2 of a cent to US\$2.18 per mmBtu and February gold advanced \$15.50 to US\$1,121.70 a troy ounce.

In New York, the Dow Jones industrial average bounced back from a 208-point decline the day before as it soared 282.01 points to 16,167.23. The S&P 500 gained 26.55 points to close at 1,903.63 and the Nasdaq added 49.18 points to 4,567.67.

In the U.S., investors also took in the beginning of a heavy corporate earnings week, as the Dow Jones industrial average lost 51.98 points at 18,086.40 and the S&P 500 faded 6.48 points to 2,126.50. The Nasdaq composite dipped 14.34 points to 5,199.82.
