By Board Order 169/09, the Public Utilities Board (Board) re-states and amends its conditional approval of Avion Services Corporation (Avion) commencing a fixed fare shuttle service between the international airport and downtown hotels.

This Order responds to requests from Avion and its parent corporation, the Winnipeg Airport Authority, that the Board review and vary its original Order with respect to three of the conditions the Board attached to its conditional approval of the shuttle service.

The Board has amended the conditions placed on the operation of the proposed service such that the essence of the Board's original direction is maintained. The Board will provide final approval for Avion to operate its proposed shuttle service only when Avion meets the conditions set by the Board. The service is, if approved, to begin between April 1 and July 1, 2010.
