



## News Release

In Order No. 59/08 dated May 14, 2008, the Public Utilities Board (Board) varied an application by the Town of Deloraine (Town) to revise its billing practices in relation to the provision of water to the Rural Municipality of Winchester (RM).

The Board amended the rates chargeable to the RM to include a provision for an equitable share of debenture debt servicing. The Board also enabled the Town to bill the RM monthly to address cash flow requirements.

<b>Steps</b> (usage measured quarterly)	<b>Current rate/ 1000 gallons</b>	<b>Approved revised rate/ 1000 gallons</b>
First 20,000 gallons	\$11.14	\$11.80
Next 80,000 gallons	\$9.30	\$9.95
Over 100,000 gallons	\$7.75	\$8.30
Quarterly Service Charge	\$10.25	\$10.25

While the service charge remains unaffected, the commodity rate increases by 7%.
