



## News Release

December 3, 2009

In Order No. 159/09 dated December 3, 2009, the Public Utilities Board (Board) approved the application of the Rural Municipality of South Norfolk (RM) for revised water rates for the Lavenham utility. The rates include a levy towards recovering the utility's estimated 2009 deficit.

Approved quarterly rates are as follows:

Jan – Oct 2011	\$ 85.00	\$30.00	\$43.00	\$158.00
Thereafter	\$100.00	\$35.00	-	\$135.00

The Board approved recovery of the 2009 projected deficit; when the deficit is known, the approved rates as set out above may be amended by the RM, as long as the change to the \$43 set out above does not involve an increase of more than \$20.
