By Order 162/11, following the Public Utilities Board's (PUB) public hearing of Manitoba Public Insurance's (MPI) 2012/13 Basic premiums and fees application, the Board amends MPI's application and directs a reduction in overall premiums of 8%. PUB approves MPI's application for enhanced fleet rebates and increased drivers' premiums for those at the top of the Driving Safety Rating scale.

PUB expresses concern over MPI's operating cost increases and certain factors that affect the fairness of premiums for Basic ratepayers, seeks more transparency with respect to the Corporation's overall operations, and directs an increased focus on road safety (calling for a conference to identify and review potential road safety measures).
