

NOTICE OF DECISION

By Order 86/11, the Public Utilities Board (PUB) varies Order 43/11 and approves additional premium rebates that will benefit 158,000 motorists.

By Order 122/10, MPI established 2011/12 Basic premiums and fees and directed a rebate of 10% be paid, this was later amended to 45%.

Following complaints from policyholders, the Board engaged in discussion with MPI with respect to taking remedial steps. The Consumers' Association of Canada (Manitoba) Inc. and the Canadian Automobile Association had jointly asked the Board to investigate the matter. This was followed by an Application by MPI to Review and Vary the Board's previous Order.

Approximately 136,000 customers who have already received some rebate amounts will receive additional rebates totaling \$11.5M. An additional 22,000 customers who did not receive any rebate and who had paid premiums during the period March 2009 to February 2010 will receive rebates totaling \$4.5M. The amount of the individual rebates varies depending on circumstances. Due to the postal disruption no date can be assured as to when policyholders will receive rebate.
