

The Public Utilities Board appoints the Independent Experts on Hydro hearings.

The Public Utilities Board has appointed a number of independent experts to provide technical advice on Manitoba Hydro's proposal to build the Keeyask and Conawapa dams and associated transmission facilities. The complex nature of the issues included in Manitoba Hydro's proposal and the significant implications for the Province require a wide range of expertise. The experts were selected following a request for qualifications and exhaustive review by the Board.

The experts will be providing reports both on the confidential and public filings of Hydro. The experts will provide testimony principally at the public hearings and exceptionally during in camera sessions.
