

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR REVISED RATES

Rural Municipality of Brokenhead-LUD of Tyndall-Garson

The Rural Municipality of Brokenhead (RM) has applied to the Public Utilities Board for revised rates for water and sewer services for the Local Urban District of Tyndall-Garson for 2013, 2014 and 2015 as set out in By-law No. 2114/12 read the first time on June 26, 2012.

A Public Notice was issued on September 11, 2012. As a result of significant response received from the RM customers, the Board will convene a Public Hearing.
