



NOTICE OF APPLICATION INTERIM SEWER RATES for Rural Municipality of GREY Fannystelle Water and Sewer Utility

July 30, 2013

The Rural Municipality of Grey (RM) has applied to the Public Utilities Board (Board) for Interim rates for the Fannystelle water and sewer utility for 2013 as set out in By-law No. 08-2013 read the first time on July 17, 2013.

The current rates and proposed rates are provided:

The Public Utilities Board is the provincial regulatory agency that reviews and approves rates for municipal water and sewer utilities. The Board's review process involves:

- the Utility filing a rate application to the Board,
- the public notification of proposed rate changes,
- the Board's review of the application through a public hearing or paper review process, and
- the issuance of a Board Order which outlines the Board's decision on the rate application and the rates to be charged.

The Board will then decide whether any further notice is required and whether to proceed with a public hearing or paper review process. All concerns received by the Board will be considered in the Board's decision on rates to be charged.
