

**NOTICE OF APPLICATION  
 REVISED WATER and SEWER RATES  
 Rural Municipality of Hanover  
 Local Improvement District of Kleefeld**

May 16, 2013

The Rural Municipality of Hanover (RM) has applied to the Public Utilities Board (Board) for revised rates for the water and sewer utility of the Local Improvement District of Kleefeld (Utility) for 2014 as set out in By-law No. 2309-13 read the first time on May 8, 2013. Rates were last revised in 2003 with Board Order No. 128/03.

The current rates and proposed rates are provided:

Details of the RM's application are available for review at the RM's office or The Public Utilities Board's office. Questions concerning the application for revised rates, or the operation of the Utility, should be addressed to the RM of Hanover.

The Public Utilities Board is the provincial regulatory agency that reviews and approves rates for municipal water and sewer utilities. The Board's review process involves:

- the Utility filing a rate application to the Board,
- the public notification of proposed rate changes,
- the Board's review of the application through a public hearing or paper review process, and
- the issuance of a Board Order which outlines the Board's decision on the rate application and the rates to be charged.

The Board will then decide whether any further notice is required and whether to proceed with a public hearing or paper review process. All concerns received by the Board will be considered in the Board's decision on rates to be charged.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT IN CONSIDERING THIS APPLICATION, THE PUBLIC UTILITIES BOARD MAY OR MAY NOT FIND IT NECESSARY TO DETERMINE RATES DIFFERENT FROM THOSE APPLIED FOR BY THE APPLICANT.
