



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING RM of Riverside- Ninette

The Rural Municipality of Riverside (RM) has applied to the Public Utilities Board (Board) for revised rates for the Ninette Sewer Utility as set out in By-law No. 8 of 2011, read the first time on November 9, 2011. Rates were last amended in 2000. A Public Notice was issued on January 27, 2012. Due to the public response to the Notice, the Board will convene a Public Hearing.
