Take notice that Ms. Delene Minty of Up In The Air Media has filed an appeal to The Public Utilities Board under the provisions of Section 21 of *The Highways Protection Act* from a decision of The Highway Traffic Board (HTB) on September 12, 2016, to deny the application for an on-premises sign (community) adjacent to P.T.H. No. 10, Parcel 7, Plan 5151, N.W. ¼ 7-19-18W within the community of Onanole, in the Municipality of Harrison Park.

This appeal shall be by way of hearing de novo and will be heard by The Public Utilities Board (PUB) at 2:00 pm, on Monday, January 9, 2017 in the Municipality of Harrison Park Office, 43 Gateway Street, Onanole, MB.

For adjacent landowners, you are advised that this Notice of Public Hearing comes to you by way of information and that it is not compulsory that you attend. If you have any comments with regard to this matter you are welcome to attend and you will be provided with an opportunity to comment.

The Manitoba Ombudsman has issued privacy guidelines for administrative tribunals. The Board is mindful of its obligations under those guidelines. Its decisions in respect of the Application being considered will be sensitive to the guidelines. Personal information will not be disclosed unless it is appropriate and necessary to do so. However, the Board advises participants that these proceedings are public and that as a



result personal information protections are reduced. The proceedings before the Board are transcribed and the transcript is posted on the Board's website. Names of Presenters and their written or oral presentations are included in the publicly available transcripts.
