The Rural Municipality of Woodworth (RM) has applied to the Public Utilities Board (Board) for revised rates for its Kenton Water and Sewer Utility (Utility) as set out in By-law No. 3-2013, read the first time on February 12, 2013. Rates were last amended in 2003. The current and proposed rates are noted below:

The Public Utilities Board is the provincial regulatory agency that reviews and approves rates for municipal water and sewer utilities. The Board's review process involves:

- the Utility filing a rate application to the Board,
- the public notification of proposed rate changes,
- the Board's review of the application through a public hearing or paper review process, and
- the issuance of a Board Order which outlines the Board's decision on the rate application and the rates to be charged.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT IN CONSIDERING THIS APPLICATION, THE PUBLIC UTILITIES BOARD MAY OR MAY NOT FIND IT NECESSARY TO DETERMINE RATES DIFFERENT FROM THOSE APPLIED FOR BY THE APPLICANT.
