REVISED NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Appeal by Manitoba Infrastructure and Transportation

Take notice that the Manitoba Infrastructure and Transportation Engineering and Operations Division – Highway Planning and Design Access Management Section, has filed an appeal to The Public Utilities Board under the provisions of Section 21 of *The Highways Protection Act* from a decision of The Highway Traffic Board issued in Winnipeg on September 23, 2015, when an application for permit allowing to erect a structure and construct access driveway was approved through Permit No. 258-15.

This appeal shall be by way of hearing de novo and will be heard by The Public Utilities Board (PUB) at **2:00 p.m., Wednesday, December 9, 2015 at the PUB's Offices, 400-330 Portage Avenue, Winnipeg, MB R3C 0C4. Teleconferencing services will be provided by the Board.** Interested parties who wish to participate in the hearing through teleconference must notify the Board Secretary by December 7, 2015. Written submissions may be submitted by mail or by email (publicutilities@gov.mb.ca).

For adjacent landowners, you are advised that this Notice of Public Hearing comes to you by way of information and that it is not compulsory that you attend. If you have any comments with regard to this matter you are welcome to attend and you will be provided with an opportunity to comment.

The Manitoba Ombudsman has recently issued privacy guidelines for administrative tribunals. The Board is mindful of its obligations under those guidelines. Its decisions in respect of the Application being considered will be sensitive to the guidelines. Personal information will not be disclosed unless it is appropriate and necessary to do so. However, the Board advises participants that these proceedings are public and that as a result personal information protections are reduced. The proceedings before the Board are transcribed and the transcript is posted on the Board's website. Names of Presenters and their written or oral presentations are included in the publicly available transcripts.
