

**STITTCO UTILITIES MAN LTD.
Proposed Non-Commodity Rate Revision
Notice of Application**

July 19, 2016

On July 14, 2016 Stittco Utilities Man Ltd. (Stittco) filed an application with the Manitoba Public Utilities Board (Board) requesting a non-commodity rate decrease of 0.68% effective November 1, 2016. Non-commodity rates recover costs incurred by Stittco for the distribution of propane to customers. The last rate adjustment to non-commodity rates occurred for rates effective November 1, 2015 in accordance with Board Order 106/15.

Stittco's current and proposed non-commodity rates are as follows:
