This is further to my letter dated July 14, 2017 including the original proposed legal budget and expert/consultant budget and my letter dated August 22, 2017 advising of the proposed blending of the GSS/GSM and KAP intervention.

As set out in my letter dated August 22, 2017, I indicated that the blending of these interventions would lead to a significant reduction in the budgets that have been proposed. Upon review of the matter I have concluded that the legal budget that was set out in my July 14, 2017 letter does not need to change.
