# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Manitoba Hydro 2019/20 Electric Rate Application

Manitoba Hydro has applied to the Public Utilities Board (Board) for a 3.5 per cent increase to all electricity rates on April 1, 2019.

**For a residential customer not on electric heat** (using an average of 1,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month), the impact of this rate increase is an additional \$3.30 per month.

**For a residential customer that has electric heat** (using an average of 2,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month), the impact of this rate increase is an additional \$6.30 per month.
