Undertaking #11

MPI to determine whether any costing has been done to date on any of the models examined, and if so, provide that information.

RESPONSE:

MPI has not calculated the implementation costs for each of the Driver Safety Rating (DSR) models it examined, but expects these costs will vary greatly between the different models. In the 2019 GRA, MPI indicated:

"DSR IMPLEMENTATION COSTS

The current DSR program was implemented in 2010 at a cost of \$6.8 million; based on the Bank of Canada's monthly Consumer Price Index (CPI), the \$6.8 million cost would equate to \$7.8 million today. The actual implementation cost of changing the current Registered Owner Model will not necessarily be \$7.8 million as the cost will depend on the alternative model selected. However, the \$7.8 million figure does provide an indication as to the possible implementation costs."

MPI has completed no model costing since that time.
