## Appendix 8: Average Regular Salary by Classification

- 1 Figure EXP App 8-1 below contains a figure displaying an average annual regular
- 2 salary per full time equivalent employee (FTE), categorized into 4 general
- 3 classifications: clerical, technical/professional, supervisor and management. The figure
- 4 shows regular salaries as an approximate average of an FTE (per respective
- 5 classification), earned in normal operations. Please note that regular salaries do not
- 6 include overtime, banked vacation, accrued vacation or retirement allowance.
- 7 Calculation for the 5-year actual figure is derived by dividing the total regular salaries
- 8 of all employees by the number of employees within each of the classifications.
- 9 Calculating the average figure involved converting the salaries of part-time and hourly
- 10 employees into FTE annual salaries. Calculation of historical values involves the use of
- point-in-time data. Calculation of the five years of forecast data (2022/23 through to
- 2026/27) requires the application of step-in-scale and economic increases to the
- 13 2021/22 projected amounts.
