

Notice of Public Hearing

Applicant: Manitoba Public Insurance Corporation

HEARING:

The Public Utilities Board (Board) anticipates holding an electronic virtual public hearing of an application from Manitoba Public Insurance Corporation (MPI) for approval of rates and premiums for compulsory vehicle and driver insurance effective April 1, 2023 through March 31, 2024. The electronic virtual hearing will be available for viewing via the PUB website link: <http://www.pubmanitoba.ca/v1/live-stream.html>. The electronic virtual public hearing will be commencing Wednesday, October 19, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.

RATE IMPACT:

MPI has applied for a provisional 0.9% rate decrease calculated in accordance with Accepted Actuarial Practice for the Basic Autopac vehicle and driver insurance rates and premiums effective April 1, 2023, until March 31, 2024.

For the 2023 rate application, MPI will update its request in advance of the public hearing to reflect the most current interest rates and financial information. The final rate request may vary from the submitted application which will be subject to testing at the public hearing, and later confirmed through an Order of the Board.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Interested parties should take note that the Board does not have jurisdiction over MPI lines of business known as Extension or Special Risk Extension (trucking), or over MPI's Driver & Vehicle Licensing operations.

Information as to MPI's application and with respect to the Board's process, as well as copies of MPI's application and supporting materials are available on the Board's website at www.pubmanitoba.ca, or by contacting the Board at 204-945-2638. As well, interested parties may examine MPI's application and supporting materials, either on the MPI website, or in the Board's office.

Persons wishing to speak at the public hearing, make a written submission, and/or address the public hearing in French must notify the Board Secretary, Dr. Darren Christle, at 204-945-2638 or toll free at 1-866-854-3698, on or before the deadline of **October 1, 2021**, and provide their full name, contact information, and a summary of the information they intend to present to the Board.

The Manitoba Ombudsman has issued privacy guidelines for administrative tribunals. The Board is mindful of its obligations under those guidelines. Decisions made by the Board in respect of the application being considered will be sensitive to the guidelines. Personal information will not be disclosed unless it is appropriate and necessary to do so. However, the Board advises participants that these proceedings are public and that as a result, the protection of personal information is reduced.
