**THE TOWN OF KILLARNEY  
WATER AND SEWER RATES  
BY-LAW NO. 2-2003**

**WHEREAS** the Town of Killarney has applied to The Public Utilities Board for approval of By-law No. 2-2003 to revised the schedule of water and sewer rates of the said Town, and after public notice of the application - no persons signifying their desire to make representation in the matter;

**AND WHEREAS** the Board notes that the utility rate study which accompanied the application provided for a sum of money to be placed in a utility reserve account, and the Board therefore desires to ensure that these moneys be expended in an appropriate fashion;

**AND WHEREAS** the Board deems it expedient to do so;

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. By-law No. 2-2003 of The Town of Killarney BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY APPROVED subject to amendment to agree with Schedule "A" to this Order;

2. The water and sewer rates set forth in Schedule "A" hereto shall apply to all customers of the utility effective on the next billing in the normal course after the date of this Order;
3. This Order is subject to moneys being expended from the utility reserve fund only to support existing infrastructure, unless the Board has authorized the expenditure pursuant to Section 168 of The Municipal and Various Acts Amendment Act, c. 58.

Fees payable upon this Order - \$50.00.

2. Minimum Charges, Quarterly

Notwithstanding the Commodity rates set forth in paragraph 1 hereof, all customers will pay the applicable minimum charges set out below, which will include water allowances indicated:

4. Water Only Customers

Customers with water only services shall be charged the minimum quarterly rate applicable to the customer's meter size less the sewer charge. Unmetered seasonal customers will be charged a flat rate of \$88.00 per season including the service charge.

5. Sewer Only for Residential Customers

Customers with sewer only services shall be charged \$35.00 per quarter.

6. Sewer Only for Commercial customers with a Private Water Supply

Larger customers connected to sewer services only and with a private water supply will meter this water at their own expense, and shall pay quarterly the service charge of \$6.50. Plus the sewer commodity rate set forth in Paragraph 1 hereof on the number of gallons of water registered by the meter on their private water supply, which will be read by the Town.

7. Bulk Sales

All water sold in bulk by the Town of Killarney shall be charged for at the rate of \$0.25 per 40 gallons or \$7.50 per 1000 gallons.

8. Service to Customers Outside the Town Limits

The Council of the Town of Killarney may sign agreements with customers for the provision of water and sewer services to properties located outside the legal boundaries of the town. Such agreements shall provide for payment of the appropriate rates set out in the schedule. As well as a surcharge, set by resolution of council, which shall be equivalent to the frontage levy, general taxes and special taxes for the utility purposes in effect at the time, and which would be levied on the property concerned if it were within these boundaries. In addition, the customer will pay all cost of connecting to the utility's mains and installing and maintaining service connections.

9. Billings and Penalties

Accounts shall be billed quarterly, and shall be due and payable 20 days after the date of billing. A penalty of five (5) percent of the amount of the bill shall be added if not paid by the due date.

10. Disconnection and Reconnection

Service may be disconnected and discontinued immediately and without further notice in the event of non-payment of the account within twenty (20) days of the due date. Any service, disconnected due to non-payment of account shall not be reconnected until all arrears, penalties and a reconnection fee

of \$20.00 have been paid. Service may be installed, disconnected, removed or reconnected upon receipt of a written request and payment of the applicable rate as set in the following:

Note: Fee of \$7.50 shall be charged to all customers for each turn-on and each turn off. The reconnection fee does not include a re-installation fee. A check valve shall be installed, at cost to the customer, with all new installations and with all renewals.

11. Outstanding Bills

Pursuant to Section 252(2) of The Municipal Act, the amount of all outstanding charges for water and sewer are a lien and charge upon the land serviced, and shall be collected in the same manner in which ordinary taxes upon the land are collectible, and with like remedies.

12. Hydrant Rentals

The Town of Killarney will pay to the Utility an annual rental of \$100.00 for each hydrant connected to the system which includes the cost of water for fire fighting.

13. Sewer Surcharges

- a) There may be levied annually, in addition to the rates set forth above, a special surcharge on sewage having a Biochemical Oxygen Demand in excess of 300 parts per million, to be set by Resolution of council.
- b) A special surcharge for substances requiring special treatment shall be charged based on the actual costs of treatment required for the particular sewage or industrial waste.
