Take notice that Mr. Marcel Lesage of Pembina Consumers Co-op (2000) Ltd., has filed an appeal to The Public Utilities Board under the provisions of Section 21 of *The Highways Protection Act* from a decision of The Highway Traffic Board (HTB) on November 17, 2015, to deny the application for a Building and Paved Parking Area adjacent to and Two Access Driveways and Remove an Access Driveway (Commercial) onto P.T.H. No. 2, Lots 2-15, Block 110, Plan 60, S.W. ¼ 4-8-21W in the Municipality of Souris-Glenwood by the Pembina Consumers Co-op (2000) Ltd.

This appeal shall be by way of hearing de novo and will be heard by The Public Utilities Board (PUB) at **2:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 19, 2016 at the Council Chambers of the City of Brandon, 2nd Floor, 410 – 9th Street, Brandon, MB.**

For adjacent landowners, you are advised that this Notice of Public Hearing comes to you by way of information and that it is not compulsory that you attend. If you have any comments with regard to this matter you are welcome to attend and you will be provided with an opportunity to comment.

The Manitoba Ombudsman has recently issued privacy guidelines for administrative tribunals. The Board is mindful of its obligations under those guidelines. Its decisions in respect of the Application being considered will be sensitive to the guidelines. Personal information will not be disclosed unless it is appropriate and necessary to do so.
