

Reminder Notice of Public Hearing

Applicant: Manitoba Public Insurance Corporation

HEARING:

The Public Utilities Board (Board) anticipates holding a public hearing of an application from The Manitoba Public Insurance Corporation (MPI) for approval of rates and premiums for compulsory vehicle and driver insurance effective April 1, 2026 through March 31, 2027. The PUB anticipates that the public hearing will commence on Monday, October 14, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. and be accessible virtually via a streaming link on the PUB website.

RATE IMPACT:

MPI has applied for a 2.07% rate increase calculated in accordance with Accepted Actuarial Practice for the Basic Autopac vehicle insurance rates and premiums effective April 1, 2026, until March 31, 2027.

The final rate request may vary from the submitted application which will be subject to testing at the public hearing and later confirmed through an Order of the Board.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Interested parties should take note that the Board does not have jurisdiction over MPI lines of business known as Extension or Special Risk Extension (commercial trucking), or over MPI's Driver & Vehicle Licensing operations.

Persons seeking further information as to MPI's application, or with respect to the Board's process, and/or wishing to address the public hearing in French should notify the Board Secretary by Monday, September 1, 2025. As well, interested parties may examine MPI's application and supporting materials, either on the MPI website, or in the Board's office.

The Manitoba Ombudsman has issued privacy guidelines for administrative tribunals. The Board is mindful of its obligations under those guidelines. Decisions made by the Board in respect of the application being considered will be sensitive to the guidelines. Personal information will not be disclosed unless it is appropriate and necessary to do so. However, the Board advises participants that these proceedings are public and that as a result, the protection of personal information is reduced.
